



MILITARY EDUCATION BENEFITS FOR DEPENDENTS

Military education benefits are certified and processed by Texas A&M Scholarships & Financial Aid office.

Examples of military education benefits for dependents:

Federal VA Chapter Benefits

Chapter 33

Transfer of Eligibility-Post 9/11 GI Bill (Veteran served after 9/11/01)

Chapter 33

Fry Scholarship- Post 9/11 GI Bill (Veteran died in line of duty after 9/11/01)

Chapter 35

Dependents' Education Assistance (DEA)- Veterands 100% disabled/unemployable due to service connected injury, Missing in Action, or has a service connected death.

State Benefits

Hazlewood Exemption* (HW)

- Legacy Program Children using transferred hours
 - Biological, step, or adopted child; or claimed as dependent on veteran's tax return
- Dependent/Spouse Program
 - Biological, step, adopted child; OR
 - Legally married to veteran

*Texas Veterans Commission establishes rules for Hazlewood eligibility. The Scholarships & Financial Aid office is required to use these rules to confirm Hazelwood exemption eligibility.






APPLYING FOR BENEFITS- 1ST TIME RECIPIENTS

Things to do now if not already done:

- 1. Register for Selective Service (if required by federal law)
- 2. Register (both the veteran AND dependent student) for Hazlewood Act Database for Veterans and Students at Texas Veterans Commissions (TVC) website, https://hazlewood.tvc.texas.gov/students/
- 3. Veteran request COE from VA (va.gov) Download digital copy

Requesting benefit for 1st time at Texas A&M University


- 1. Log into the HOWDY portal with Netid and password at *howdy.tamu.edu*
- 2. Click the Financial Aid Portal ICON at the top of Howdy





APPLYING FOR BENEFITS

- Select appropriate Academic Year
 - *Summer is the last semester in the year
- 2. Select <u>First Time Military</u>
 <u>Education Benefit Request</u>
 under Helpful Links
- 3. Answer questions and submit
- 4. Select 'Status' to view list of required documents
- 5. Upload digital/scanned documentation in portal
 - * Documents not accepted in person



APPLYING FOR BENEFITS

Important Reminders BEFORE eligible military education benefits can be processed:

- 1. Must have requested benefit in Financial Aid portal.
- All required documents must be submitted regularly monitor the Status (or To Do) tab on the Financial Aid portal
- 3. Student must register for classes that will fulfill their degree requirements*



Tools to help students monitor their course registration and degree applicability:



- My
 Dashboard>My
 Record>Schedule
- My
 Dashboard>My

 Evaluation

*Students will need to ensure they are registering for courses that count towards their CURRENT degree program on file in order to be certified for VA benefits for those courses.

BENEFIT PROCESSING TIMELINES & PRIORITY PROCESSING

Depending on when events on previous slide have been completed, the average processing times are as follows:

- Priority Deadline for Requesting Benefits processing time is 5-7 business days
 - Spring terms: December 1st
 - Summer terms: May 1st
 - Fall terms: August 1st
- AFTER Priority deadline Processing may take up to 10-12 business days to complete.
 - Will need to allow for additional processing time as this is generally a peak processing period.
- Processing time estimate starts once request is submitted, all documents are uploaded, and student has registered.



APPLYING FOR BENEFITS CONTINUED

Take Note:

- Tuition benefits will apply to the bill.
- Student will be responsible for paying balance by the due date(s) to avoid late payment penalties.
- Housing and book stipends are paid directly to the student by the VA, and paid in arrears (ex: August stipend is paid in September)
- Remember to request to RENEW your benefit <u>each</u> semester; by the
 priority deadline dates to ensure benefit is able to be processed by the
 payment due date.

FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS

- You CAN receive military education benefits, financial aid, and scholarships at the same time!
- FAFSA (Financial Aid Application)
 - https://studentaid.gov/
 - Opens on or after October 1 for the next academic year
- University Scholarship Application
 - https://uwide.tamu.edu
 - Opens every October 15 for the next academic year
 - Closes on February 1
 - Be sure to answer all necessary military related questions!



MILITARY EDUCATION BENEFITS CONTINUED

- Military In Texas Non-Resident Tuition Waiver*
 - Available for Veterans, Dependents, Active duty, and Reservists
 - Requires an Intent to Establish Residency in Texas
 - Visit https://aggie.tamu.edu/ for details
- TVC Deferment (HB846)*
 - Delays the due date for tuition and fees up to 90 days to allow time for benefits to process
 - Complete form if you have applied for benefits and they are not processed by the billing due date
 - Can be used for delays in GI Bill, Hazlewood, VR&E, Fry Scholarship, etc.
