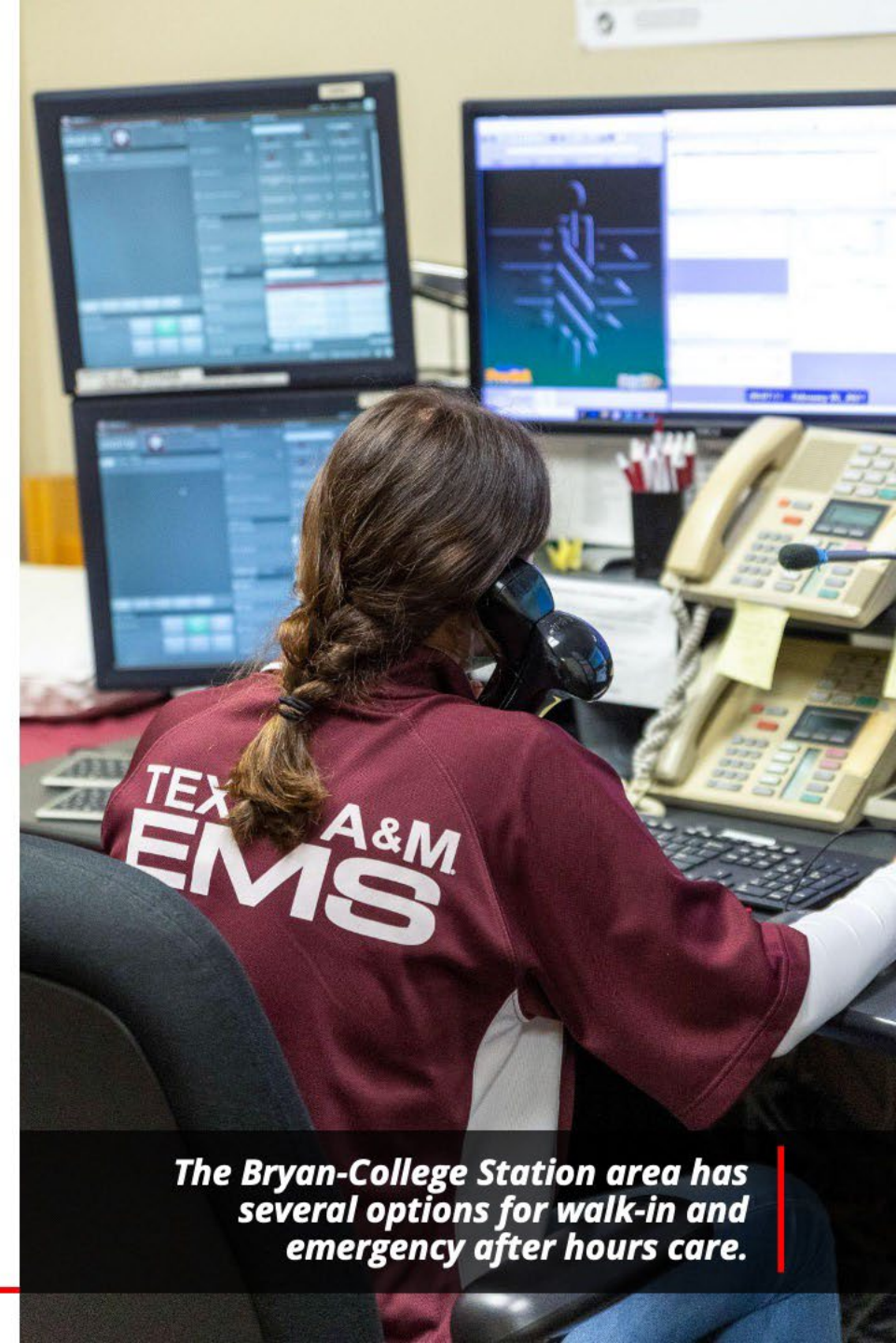
Emergency & After-Hours Resources
