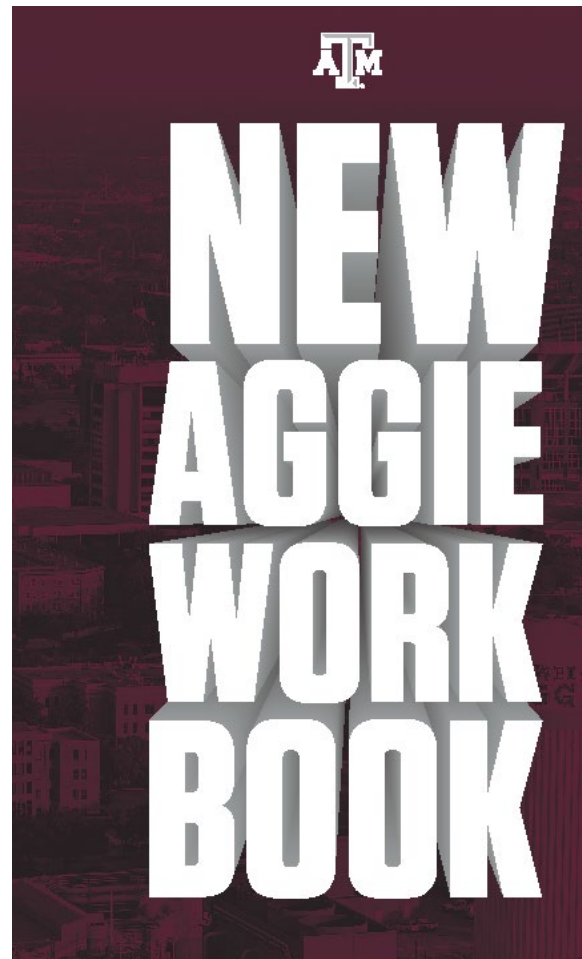

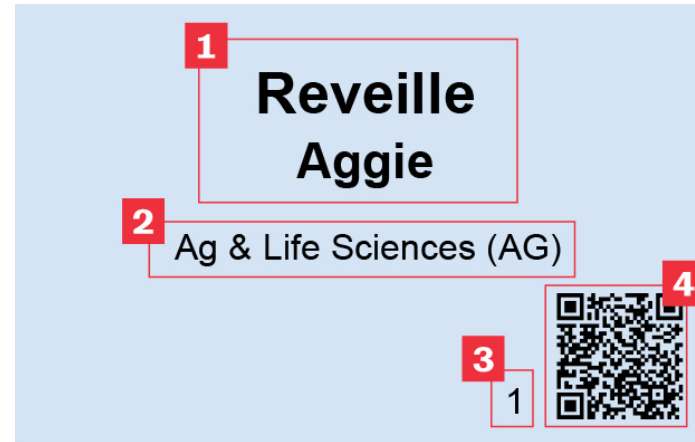

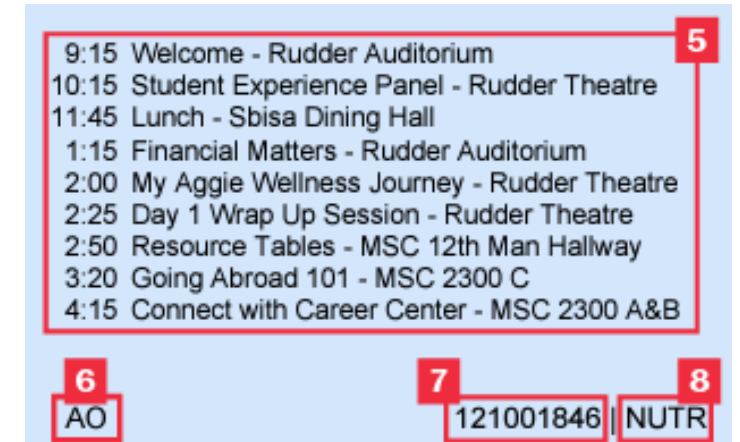

- In general, developing countries tend to have significantly lower economic and social indicators than developed countries on average
- United Nations' Human Development Index (HDI) is the most comprehensive measure of a country's development. It integrates both social & economic dimensions
- We consider a Developing country = A nation with a low Human Development Index and a low level of industrialization
