

### Disbursement of Aid

- 10 days prior to the first class day each semester
  - Spring 2019 Disbursement Begins ---- January 5, 2019
- Dependent upon:
  - Registration in classes
  - Enrollment in classes that apply to your degree
  - Must not have any outstanding required documents
    - Loan documents
      - Entrance Counseling
      - Master Promissory Note (MPN)
    - Verification Documents
      - Tax transcript
      - Verification Form
    - Final High School Transcript

### Maintaining Eligibility – Federal, State, Institutional Aid

- Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)
- Monitored at the end of every semester
- Undergrads
  - Must maintain 2.0 cumulative GPA
  - Must complete 75% of registered courses
  - Must not exceed 134% of degree program requirements
    - Includes transfer coursework
- Different requirements for graduate and professional students



### Maintaining Eligibility

- Courses must count towards the degree you are seeking
- Courses are reviewed once registration begins
- To view what courses count, visit the Howdy Portal, click the My Finances tab, and enter the Financial Aid channel
- Discuss with your Academic Advisor if needed

\* Courses listed as "Pending Review" will be evaluated as part of a nightly process and should have an updated status within 24 hours. Courses marked "Yes" are considered eligible for federal aid purposes, and those marked "No" are not currently applied to your program of study, thus not counted toward your eligibility for federal student aid.

You must have a minimum number of financial aid eligible hours in order to receive certain types of federal financial aid. Failure to enroll in these minimum hours may impact your financial aid package, including institutional and state aid.



#### Emergency Tuition and Fees Loan

- Pays tuition and required fees only
- Repayment term of up to 90 days
- Apply online through Howdy Portal

#### Short Term Loan

- Can be used for rent, books, and other educational costs
- Repayment term of up to 12 months
- Apply online through Howdy Portal



### Subsequent Years at A&M

- FAFSA must be renewed annually
  - Fall 2019 Spring 2020 FAFSA available now!
    - Opened October 1, 2018
    - Uses your 2017 taxes
  - Fall 2020 Spring 2021 FAFSA
    - Opens October 1, 2019
    - Uses your 2018 taxes

## **Tuition Information**



### **Tuition Rate Code** refers to a tuition S plan that sets the amount of tuition D and required fees at a per semester rate for 12 consecutive semesters after high school.






Note: Available ONLY for Resident Students (incoming resident freshmen, transfer and re-admit students)



## **Tuition Rate Code** refers to a tuition S plan where the amount of tuition **D** and required fees could vary from year to year.






Note: Optional for Resident Students but all Non-Resident students will default to this plan.
