

# FINANCIAL AID FOR THE FALL

- Sfyddawr't applied for aid, you still can www.fafsa.gov
  - School Code 003632
- Be sure to complete the process in the Financial Aid Portal accessible through howdy.tamu.edu
- Report any scholarships using the online Student Data Form
- Mail scholarship checks to: Scholarships & Financial Aid PO Box 30016 College Station, TX 77842





#### **DISBURSEMENT OF AID**

- 10 days prior to the first class day each semester
  - Fall 2019 Disbursement Begins ---- August 17, 2019
- Dependent upon:
  - Registration in classes
  - Enrollment in classes that apply to your degree
  - Must not have any outstanding required documents
    - Loan documents
      - Entrance Counseling
      - Master Promissory Note (MPN)
    - Verification Documents
      - Tax transcript
      - Verification Form
    - Final High School Transcript



#### MAINTAINING ELIGIBILITY

- Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP)
- Monitored at the end of every semester
- Undergrads
  - Must maintain 2.0 cumulative GPA
  - Must complete 75% of registered courses
  - Must not exceed 134% of degree program requirements
    - Includes transfer coursework
- Different requirements for graduate and professional students



#### MAINTAINING ELIGIBILITY

- Courses must count towards the degree you are seeking
- Courses are reviewed once registration begins
- To view what courses count, visit the Howdy Portal, click the My Finances tab, and enter the Financial Aid channel
- Discuss with your Academic Advisor if needed

Courses marked "Yes" are considered eligible for federal aid purposes, and those marked "No" are not currently applied to your program of study, thus not counted toward your eligibility for federal student aid.

You must have a minimum number of financial aid eligible hours in order to receive certain types of federal financial aid. Failure to enroll in these minimum hours may impact your financial aid package, including institutional and state aid.

# NEED TUITION MONEY? MONEY FRANCES Loan


- Pays tuition and required fees only

- Apply online through Howdy Portal

  - Opens October 1, 2019
  - Uses your 2018 taxes
- Apply for Scholarships annually
  - University Scholarship Application at scholarships.tamu.edu
  - Opens: October 15, 2019
  - Deadline: February 1, 2020



# **TUITION INFORMATION**



#### **TUITION RATE CODE**

#### **TUITION LOCKED RATE (TLR)**

A tuition plan that sets the amount of tuition and required fees at a per semester rate for 12 consecutive semesters after high school.

Note: Available ONLY for Resident Students (incoming resident freshmen, transfer and readmit students)

#### **TUITION VARIABLE RATE (TVR)**


A tuition plan where the amount of tuition and required fees could vary from year to year.

Note: Optional for Resident Students but all Non-Resident students will default to this plan.



## TUITION CALCULATOR

- A tool that gives you an estimate of your tuition cost based on information you provide
- Special provisions apply to tuition and fee costs for Distance Education students as well as on-campus students with 700 levels courses






## **TEXAS GUARANTEED TUITION PLAN (TGTP)**








#### **AUTHORIZED USER**


To allow someone such as a family member, spouse, or partner, to view and pay your bill, you must designate them as an **Authorized User.**


#### **Online Payments**


#### **REFUNDS**






