





#FIRST GEN VETS



State Benefits

*All programs depend upon veteran eligibility, which is determined by Scholarships & Financial Aid





IMPORTANT VA NOTICE

The VA is scheduled to launch a new benefit processing database in **Spring 2023**.


- There will be a period in which no school will be able to certify benefits.
- Nonetheless, please <u>request</u> benefits ASAP and <u>submit</u> all requested documents via the Financial Aid Portal. Once the new VA system is available, benefits will be processed in the order received.
- Scholarships & Financial Aid will work with Student Business Services to make sure that VA tuition and fee benefit students who have applied but unable to be processed will not be dropped from courses nor assessed any late fees.
- This delay will also impact monthly housing allowances/payments.



APPLYING FOR BENEFITS

Take Note:

- All courses are run through a degree audit and must count towards CURRENT degree plan on file in order to be certified for VA benefits
- Benefit renewal must be requested <u>each</u> semester
- Priority Deadlines:
 - Spring- December 1
 - Summer- May 1
 - Fall- August 1

 - VA Form 22-1990t

- Military In Texas Non-Resident Tuition Waiver*
 - Available for Veterans, Dependents, Active duty, and Reservists
 - Requires and Intent to Establish Residency in Texas
 - Visit https://aggie.tamu.edu/ for details
- TVC Deferment (HB846)*
 - Delays the due date for tuition and fees up to 90 days to allow time for benefits to process
 - Complete form if benefits are not processed by end of first week of classes
 - Can be used for delays in GI Bill, Hazlewood, VR&E, Fry Scholarship, etc.

FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS

- You CAN receive military education benefits, financial aid, and scholarships at the same time!
- FAFSA (Financial Aid Application)
 - https://studentaid.gov/
 - Opens every October 1 for the *next* academic year
- University Scholarship Application
 - https://uwide.tamu.edu
 - Opens every October 15 for the *next* academic year
 - Closes on February 1
 - Be sure to check the veteran indicator and answer all necessary military related questions!


