PBSI 105 (section 500 **OR** 501) - 1 hr (**MANDATORY**)

PBSI 301 - 4hrs (<u>HIGHLY RECOMMENDED</u>)

Creative Arts or Social Science or Language, Philosophy & Culture - 3 hrs

Life and Physical Sciences - 3hrs

US History or POLS - 3 hrs

- 2) You will register for PBSI 105 on your own.
- 3) You must email <u>jennifer-fleming@tamu.edu</u>.
- 4) You MUST INCLUDE your Name, UIN, and a 1st/2nd option with course name and CRN.
- 5) You will receive a return email stating which option you received.
- 6) If you have a HOLD, you are NOT able to register for ANY classes until that HOLD is removed.
- 7) Failure to follow these instructions will result in a denied request.

- 200-299 SECTION numbers are HONORS (you must be in a <u>HONORS program NOW</u>)
- 598, 599 and 700 SECTIONS are ONLINE (CHECK FEES)
- You <u>CANNOT</u> register for:
 - *600-699 **COURSE** numbers (graduate students)
 - *Any **SECTION** beginning with M (McAllen courses)
