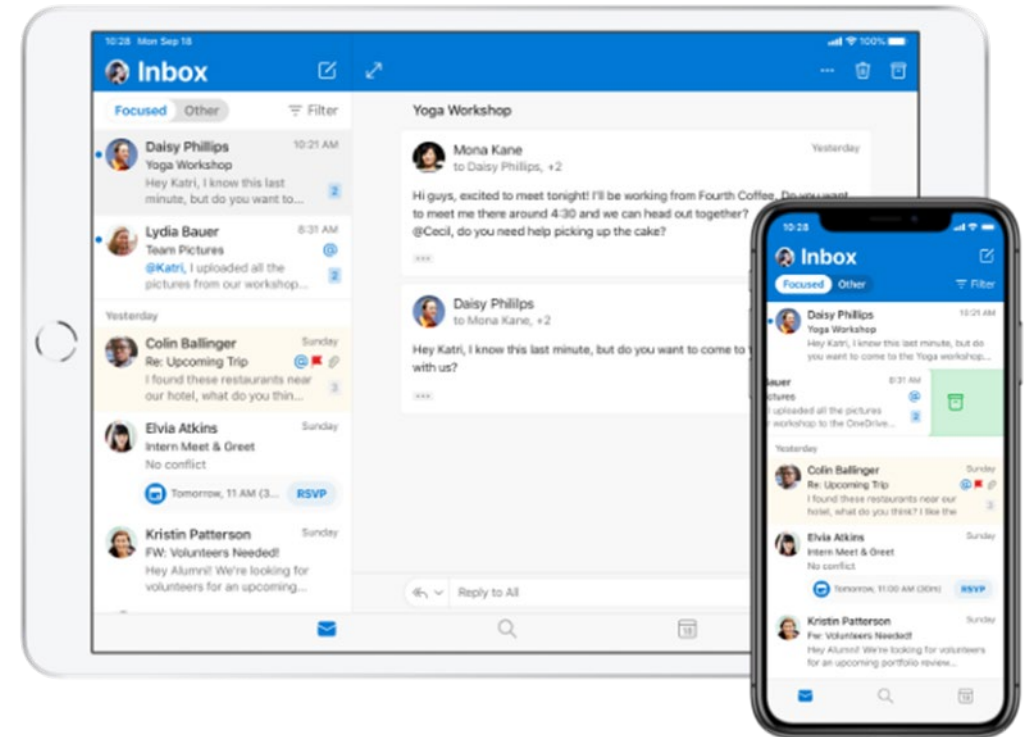


University Policy and Expectations



TAMU Email

Add/Drop Policy

- **Fall or Spring Semesters**
 - Through the 5th day of class (by 5pm)
- **Summer Terms**
 - By the 4th day of class (by 5pm)



Core Curriculum Requirements

- Requirements MUST be met by ALL students seeking a baccalaureate degree
- Core requirements are built into your degree
- Check with your advisor before selecting courses
 - Some degrees have classes they want you to take to fulfill core requirements
 - Not all core curriculum courses meet YOUR degree requirements



Q-Drop Policy

Q-drop without academic penalty

Fall or Spring – first 60 days of class


Summer – first 15 days of class

Shows a “Q” on your transcript

4 Q-drops allowed at TAMU

Transfers: 6 Drops from all state institutions

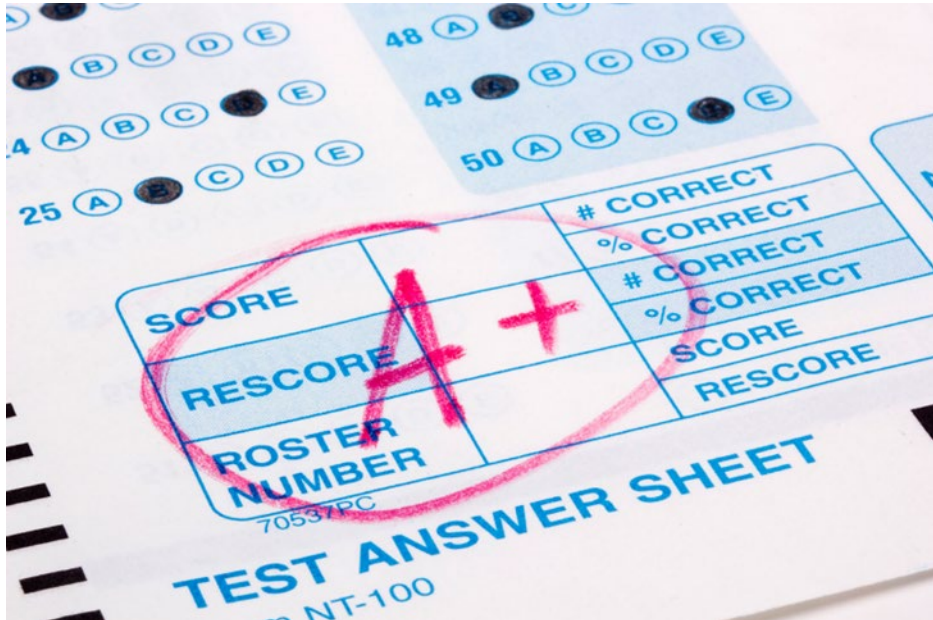


Withdrawal from the University

- Same date as Q-drop Deadline
- All classes graded as “W”
- W grades – no affect on GPA
- Student is responsible for completing the withdrawal process
- Process is online – in Howdy Portal
- Check with Financial Aid BEFORE you withdraw



Grades: Good Standing



TAMU operates on a 4.0 GPR system

2.0 GPR in good standing with the University

Your major may have a higher GPA requirement!

Teachers must have a 2.75 which is required by the state



Grade Information

- Five passing grades: **A, B, C, D,** and **S**
- **"D"** passing – may not count towards your major
- **"F"** failing grade – no grade points, hours included in GPR
- **"X"** grade - grade not submitted by professor
- **"I"** Incomplete – temporary grade
 - Given at the discretion of instructor
 - Must be completed the next semester



College Academic Probation & Dismissal

NOT ALL MAJORS ALLOW PROBATION

- **Warning letter**
 - GPR below 2.0 for semester; Overall above a 2.0
- **Major GPA Probation and Dismissal**
 - Not meeting major GPA requirements
- **School Probation/Dismissal**
 - Can be dismissed after one bad semester
 - No guarantee of readmission
 - Opportunity to appeal
- **University Dismissal**
 - Out for a full year
 - Can be dismissed after one bad semester

Distinguished Student Dean's Honor Roll

Undergraduate

15 hours in fall or spring semester

12 hours in summer

No grade lower than a "C"

First semester freshman – no "Q" drops

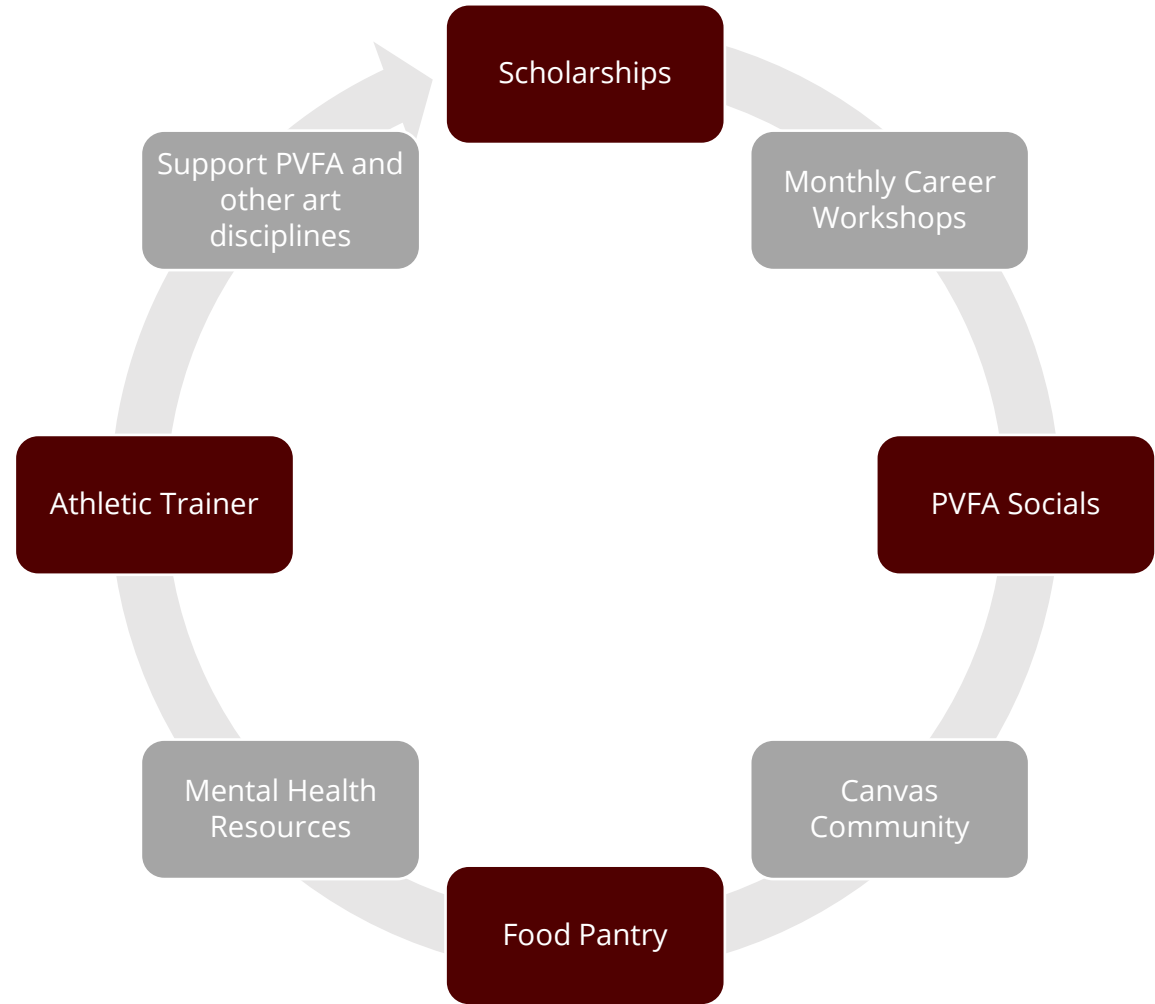
- Distinguished Student – 3.5 to 3.74 GPR
- Dean's Honor Roll – 3.75 GPR and above
- Students notified by email
