- ❑ Do I have to complete CHEM + BIOL + MATH my first term?
 - ❑ It is highly recommended that you register for these three; otherwise, you may take MATH with Organic Chemistry and PHYS.

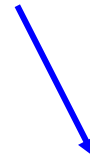
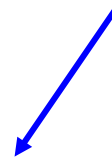

FAQ

- ❑ The degree plan emailed to me was blank however, I have AP/IB and/or dual credit, do I need to take the course(s) I earned credit for?
 - ❑ Not for a core class such as HIST or ENGL. However, you may need to register for science courses you have credit for depending on your future plan ie: MED school.

- ❑ Do I have to follow the order of the degree plan?
 - ❑ Yes, all BIMS students must meet all degree requirements. Ensure you are done with CBKs by first semester junior year.

- ❑ Am I required to complete BIMS 101?
 - ❑ No, BIMS 101 is no longer required. Can use AP/IB/Dual credit or a 1hr. course.
