Tuition Rate Plan

Select rate plan option in Howdy>Registration Readiness icon>Action Items

- TUITION LOCKED RATE (TLR)
 Resident Students Only

 - Locks in the amount of tuition and required fees at a per semester rate for 12 consecutive semesters after high school.
- TUITION VARIABLE RATE (TVR)

Resident and Non-resident Students

- Amount of tuition and can vary from year to year based on different economic factors.
- CALCULATED LOCKED RATE

Transfer and Re-Admit Resident Students Only

Locks in the amount of tuition and required fees that was in effect the first term of enrollment in college.

Must make final selection by the 5th day of class of Spring term. Plan selection is locked in and cannot be changed after this date.

Tuition Freeze

As a result of actions taken by the Texas Legislature to address affordability in higher education, **tuition and fees will remain at the 2024-2025 rate for the 2025-2026 and 2026-2027 academic years**

- Undergraduate students only
- Texas residents only



- Payments
- Refunds (if applicable)



Understanding Your Bill

Charges

- Common required charges for first time students
 - Tuition and required course fees
 - General deposit
 - University Advancement Fee
 - Memorial Student Center, Health Center, and Recreation Center fees
- Optional services/charges
 - Distance education differential tuition
 - Book fees for courses participating in Barnes & Noble First Day Program
 - o On-campus housing, dining, parking, sports passes, etc.

Payments

- Personal payments
- Scholarships and financial aid applied
- Tuition waivers/exemptions if applicable
- 529 payments
- 3rd party payment contracts/checks

Understanding Your Bill

Refunds

- Credit balance on account due to excess financial aid
 - Title IV Refund federal financial aid in excess of required tuition and fees, housing and meals
 - Non-title IV Refund non-federal aid in excess of total balance due
- Credit balance on account due to excess personal payment, dropping a course, or other reversal of charges
 - Released after the add/drop registration period ends (5th class day)

PAYMENT OPTIONS & DUE DATES

January 17, 5 p.m.

Pay in Full

- e-Checks/ACH Payment (Free)
 - Includes debit cards
 - Recommend submitting e-Check instead of mailing a paper check
- Credit Cards
 - A service fee is applied for credit card payments.

Payment Plan

- \$50 non-refundable service fee
- Payment Plan payment auto withdrawal dates:
 - 1st payment January 17th
 - 2nd payment February 17th
 - 3rd payment March 17th
 - 4th payment April 17th



Failure to pay on-time may result in late fees and/or loss of access to courses!




AUTHORIZED USERS (AUs)

- Students add and manage Authorized User (AU) access to their student billing account.
 - Email sent to AU to setup account login
- Authorized Users are able to view bills and remit payments to the student bill.
- Multiple Authorized Users can be granted access to the account.
- Refunds from student account issued to student, not Authorized User*
- Authorized User access for bill payment is not the same as Parent/Guardian access to Howdy
 - Parent/Guardian access will change in March 2025. Watch for emails with more info.

*Only Parent Plus Loan refund option for parent.

BILL PAYMENT SUITE



DIRECT DEPOSIT

Students will set up direct deposit for their refund.

- Log in to <u>howdy.tamu.edu</u> with NetID and password
- 2. Select <u>Payment/Refund</u> icon & directed to Bill Payment Suite
- 3. Go to the **eRefunds tab**
- 4. Select **Enroll for eRefunds**
- 5. Provide required US bank info
- 6. Agree to Terms & Conditions
- 7. Click **Submit**
- 8. Review and Confirm




REFUNDS

Refunds are issued to the <u>student</u> via direct deposit.

Examples when refunds are issued:

- Overpayment
- Financial aid and scholarships exceeding total bill
- Drop below full-time enrollment reducing amount due
 - Flat tuition rate charged for 12+ hours



FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS

Accepted aid applied to the bill for eligible students

- No earlier than 10 days prior to the start of each semester
- All "to do" items complete in the Financial Aid Portal
- Runs daily in early mornings to disburse aid to the bill

Outside Scholarships

- Must be received in order to apply to bill
- If not received by bill due date, alternative payment arrangements must be made
 - Mailed checks
 - Allow at least 2 weeks to process
 - In-person drop box
 - 1st floor lobby of General Services Complex (outside Aggie One Stop)
 - Allow up to 1 week to process

Texas Guaranteed Tuition Plan

- Will pay for the number of credit hours purchased under the student's plan
- Does not cover laboratory fees, course-specific fees, room, board, books, sport passes
- Request TGTP in <u>howdy.tamu.edu</u>
- Instructions at <u>TGTP.tamu.edu</u>
- Plan will cover fall and spring
- Email questions to <u>ssb@tamu.edu</u>



Texas Tuition Promise Fund

- Must be authorized <u>every semester</u> on the TTPF website
- Account Purchaser must authorize payment to an in-state Texas public college, university, or community college
- To authorize TTPF to pay Texas A&M University for the semester, visit <u>texastuitionpromisefund.com</u>



529 PLANS

- Use tuition calculator to estimate tuition costs
- Contact your plan administrator to inquire how they send payment
 - Some plans can transfer funds electronically to TAMU
 - Most mail checks
 - May take up to 2-3 weeks on average to receive
 - Payment may not be arrive by payment due date; be prepared to make alternate payment arrangements by payment due date
- Alternate payment considerations:
 - Payment plan sign up & make first payment by due date
 - Emergency Tuition and Fees Loan use to pay tuition and required fees

WAIVERS & EXEMPTIONS

- Various state tuition waivers or exemptions are available for certain for eligible students
- Scan QR code in the NSC workbook for full list of waivers/exemptions or visit <u>aggie.tamu.edu</u>
- Deadline to submit required documentation:
 - 12th class day for the fall and spring
 - 4th class day for summer
- Email Specialized Student Billing at <u>ssb@tamu.edu</u> for questions

THIRD PARTY SPONSORS

- Special payments provided by third parties include but not limited to:
 - Texas Workforce Commission
 - Employer tuition assistance programs
 - Military tuition assistance programs
 - International/foreign student sponsors
- Must make arrangements through Specialized Student Billing

INSTITUTIONAL LOANS

 Emergency Tuition and Fee loans

Short Term loans



EMERGENCY TUITION AND FEE LOAN

- Pays required tuition and fees only
- Repayment up to 90 days
- A \$10 processing fee
- 5% simple interest

SHORT TERM LOANS

- Temporary funding that can be used for rent, books and other educational costs
- Repayment terms from 1 to 12 months
- A \$10 processing charge calculated on each loan's total amount
- 8%* simple interest per annum

* If the loan is not paid by the due date, additional late charges of 0.5% per month will accrue on the unpaid principal balance until paid in full.



GRADGUARD TUITION PROTECTION PLAN






- Submit 2024-2025 FAFSA or TASFA for Spring 2025 and Summer 2025
- Explore alternative loans at <u>aggie.tamu.edu</u>
- Submit 2025-2026 FAFSA or TASFA now for next academic year (Fall 2025, Spring 2026 & Summer 2026)

• Fall 2025

- Submit the University Scholarship Application for 2026-2027
 - <u>uwide.tamu.edu</u>
 - Opens October 15, 2025
 - Closes February 1, 2026

PARENT PLUS LOAN

- Parent PLUS Loans are <u>applied to charges</u> before other aid
- Refund will issue to the student <u>UNLESS</u> parent elects refund issued to self/parent when applying
- To change PLUS refund preference
 - <u>aggie.tamu.edu</u> > Resources > Forms and Media > Loans > PLUS Refund Authorization
 - Parents who are also Authorized Users can set up direct deposit in the bill payment site

WHAT COULD DELAY MY FINANCIAL AID?

- 1.Offered aid has NOT been accepted in their Financial Aid Portal
- 2. Final HS transcript not received (for TEXAS Grant recipients)
- 3. Need to complete To Do items under Status in financial aid portal
- 4. Not enrolled in enough hours to be eligible for the aid
- 5. Not enough courses are counting towards their degree plan
- 6.Entrance counseling for Direct Loans not completed
- 7. Master Promissory Note for Direct Loans not completed

RECEIVING FINANCIAL AID

Accepted grants, loans, and scholarships apply to the bill

Outside Scholarships


- Must be received in order to apply to bill
- Allow 2 weeks if mailed
- Allow 1 week if put in drop box at Aggie One Stop

Work Study

- Student works at job & paycheck issued to student
- Does NOT get applied directly to bill
- Find a job at jobsforaggies.tamu.edu

MAINTAINING FINANCIAL AID ELIGIBILITY



- Courses must count toward your degree plan
 Impacts federal aid eligibility and the Cost of
 - Attendance
- View if courses are financial aid eligible
 - View your Schedule in the Howdy Portal
 - My Dashboard tab > My Record
 - FAID Eligible column indicates if the course counts
 - Allow one business day after registering or changing your degree plan
- Discuss your degree plan with Academic Advisor

- Monitored at the end of every semester
- Undergraduate students must
 - Maintain 2.0 cumulative GPA
 - Complete 75% of registered courses
 - Not exceed 134% of degree program requirements
