"I was intimidated; I didn't get involved, and at times I was really overwhelmed, and I reached out to no one. Yeah, a mistake.


"I learned how bad I was at studying... and my girlfriend at home couldn't visit me as much as we thought."


Test Taking Anxiety Supplemental Instructions
