# **Holds and Action Items**

- Holds: indicate action needs to be taken; can impact one or more services (e.g., course registration, obtaining transcripts, and graduation)
- Action Items: tasks that must be completed each semester before registration (e.g., Terms of Use, Location Update, etc.)

# **Online Orientation (AO)**

- Series of modules designed to deliver timely and relevant information pertinent to success at the NSC.
  - Reviews resolving holds, finances, logistics of the NSC, and information about your academic unit.
- Should take no more than an hour to complete.
- Available in the first week of May; instructions for accessing will be sent via email when launched.
- Must be completed three business days before NSC (i.e., if your NSC is on Tuesday, Online Orientation should be completed by Thursday)
- Hold should resolve immediately upon completion.

# Tuition Rate (AL)

- Students classified as Texas residents for the purpose of tuition must select a tuition rate.
- Non-resident students will be assigned the variable-rate plan.
- Hold should resolve immediately upon selection.

# **Bacterial Meningitis (AM)**

- Texas Senate Bill 1107 (now TEC 51.9192) requires all students to submit proof of vaccination against Bac Men or meet criteria for declining.
- Upload documentation to Med+Proctor (DO NOT PAY TO EXPEDITE)
- Must be submitted two weeks before NSC.
  - Forms will be processed in the order they are received, regardless of NSC date.

### **NSC Attendance (AN)**

- Hold for non-attendance of NSC
  - Hold could be from a previous term or mean that you reschedule after name tags were printed.
- Stop by the Help Desk at your NSC to speak with a professional staff member who can remove the hold.

# **Common Holds for International Students**

### **Tuberculosis Screening (IM)**

- Required for all incoming international students who were born in or resided in a high-risk country for more than three months.
- Email Screening Form and T-Spot blood test results to <u>tbhold@tamu.edu</u> or fax to 979-458-8319.
- Hold should release 24-48 hours following submission.

### International Student Check-In (IC)

- International students with an
  F-1 or J-1 visa must check in with International Student & Scholar Services (ISSS).
- Complete online after arriving to the US or Texas A&M University.
- Must be completed by the last day of add/drop period.
