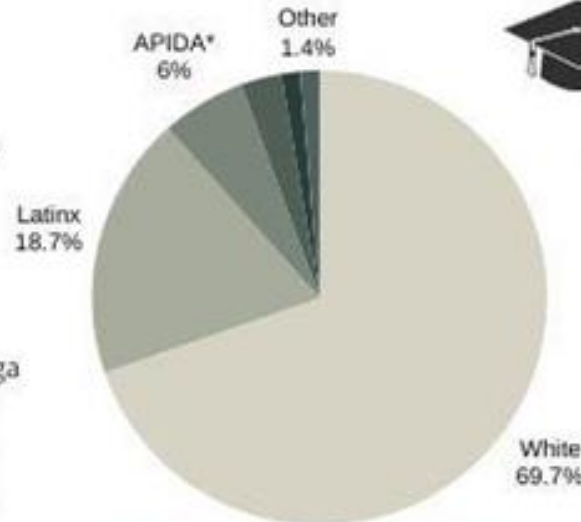

**Joining Process:** Primary recruitment takes place prior to the start of the fall semester.
