

It's an Aggie Tradition


- Top ranking university for sending students abroad



- TAMU credit
 - \circ Faculty-led, Field Trip
- Transfer credit
 - Affiliate Provider, Exchange

- 1 week to 1 school year in duration

- Dual application process

- Texas A&M Faculty/Staff and Students
- Primarily Summer and Winter Break
 programs
- Some semester long programs
- Great for students who want to take specific TAMU courses abroad and build a close relationship with fellow Aggies and trip leaders.

Field Trips



- Texas A&M Credit and Tuition
- Texas A&M Faculty/Staff and Students
- Majority of course taught on-campus, remainder taught abroad
- Range from 1-2 weeks
- Spring Break, Winter Break, and Summer
- Great for first-time travelers
- Fits into busy schedules
- One application

Other Experiences

- Student Groups, other group programs
- Independent Experience
 - $_{\odot}$ Transfer Credit, TAMU Credit, or No Credit
 - Any experience that is not through an affiliate or a sponsored A&M program listed in the portal
- Texas A&M University students are required to register their international travel with Education Abroad for risk management purposes and compliance, per the University Student Travel Rule 13.04.99.M1.








