Holistic Admissions

- Prerequisite GPA
 - *3.3 minimum overall*
- Nursing Science GPA
 - *3.3 minimum required*
- HESI A2 Exam
 - *Considered for Traditional and Second Degree BSN*
 - *75% per section minimum*
- **Experience & Attributes**



Prerequisite Coursework

Core Curriculum 34 Credits

- **Communications/English** - 6 hours
- **History** - 6 hours
- **Federal Government** - 3 hours
- **Texas Government** - 3 hours
- **Language, Philosophy & Culture**
 - Philosophy/Ethics - 3 hours (recommended)
- **Creative Arts** - 3 hours
- **Math** - 3 hours from TAMU Core
- **Nutrition** - 3 hours
- **Life & Physical Science**
from one of the following:
 - Biology - 4 hours
 - Chemistry II - 4 hours
 - Physics - 4 hours
 - Zoology - 4 hours

Nursing Science Courses 25 Credits

- **Social & Behavioral Science**
 - General Psychology - 3 hours (required)
- **Lifespan Psychology** - 3 hours
- **Chemistry** - 4 hours
- **Microbiology** - 4 hours
- **Statistics** - 3 hours
- **Anatomy & Physiology** - 8 hours

Total of 59 Credit Hours

Foreign Language Proficiency

Courses may be in progress or planned at the time of application cycle. However, applicants must have completed a minimum of 40 prerequisite course credit hours of the 59 hours listed.

Of those 40, twelve (12) credit hours must be from the Nursing Science curriculum

Credit Earned in High School

AP, IB, CLEP

Must meet minimum scores

Credits must be included on college transcript

Not used in GPA calculations

Dual enrollment

Refer to Texas common course numbers

Used in GPA calculations

Transfer Credits

Students with courses from another Texas public college or university may be able to use a course from the previous institution's core; talk to an advisor.

Repeated Coursework Policy

Grades of D or F in any prerequisite course must be repeated with a C or better. The grade from the first and second attempt will be averaged together.

Applicants with two prerequisite course failures (D or F) within the last 5 years will be ineligible for admission.

Pre-reqs completed by end of summer semesters.
