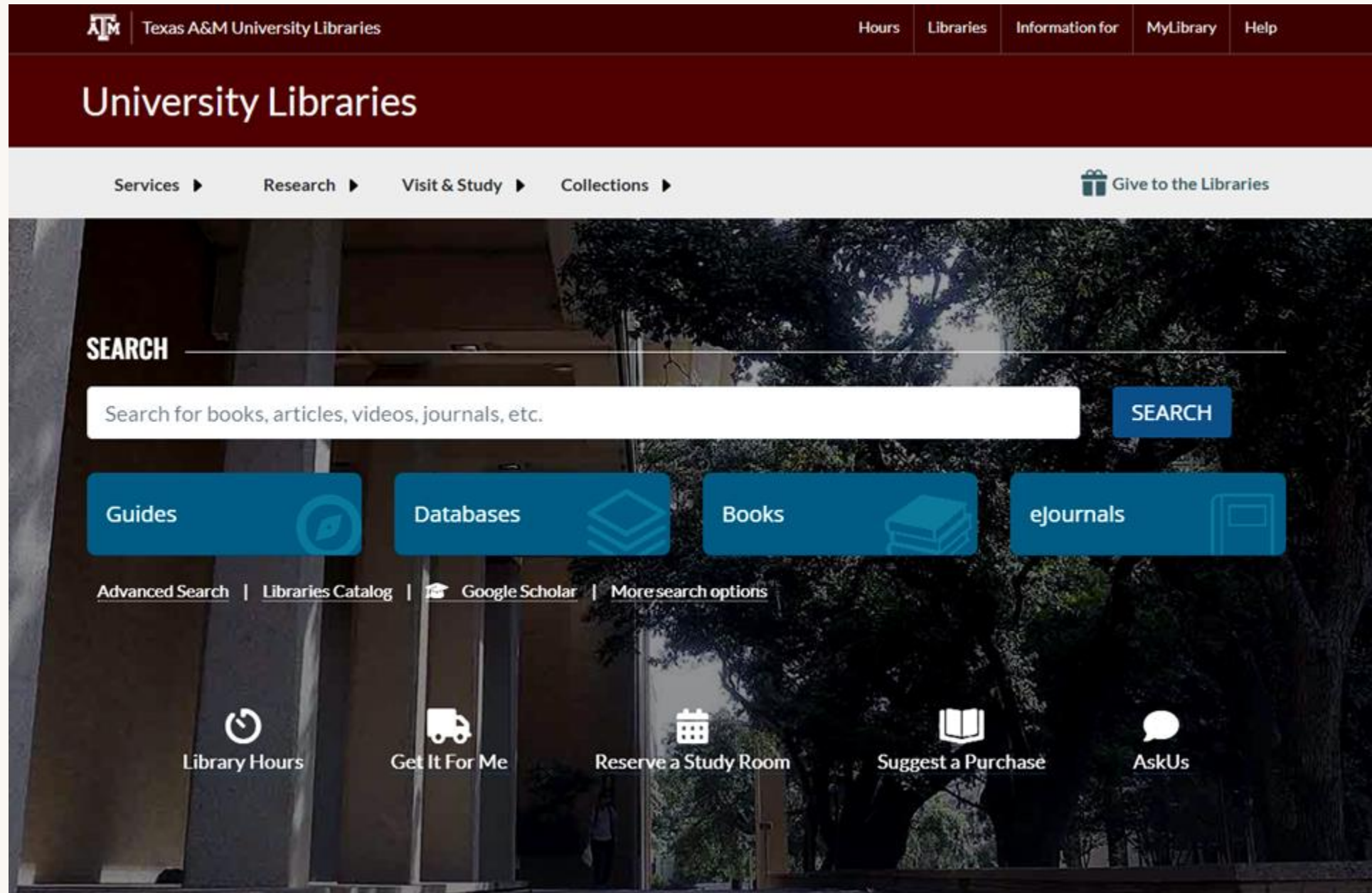


Medical Sciences Library

Making material accessible

Course Reserves

Textbooks are expensive!
Before you buy them, check to see if the library has what you need available.

Course Reserves are print or digital materials that your professor makes available.

Bonus - If it is not already available, YOU can also request material!

Libraries' Catalog

Check the Libraries Catalog to find class books, ebooks, other materials, and for recreational reading.

If you need help finding what you need, go to AskUs! Ask a Librarian!

Bonus - Best Sellers and Graphic Novels and other Recreational Reading options

Printing and Scanning

Did you know you get \$30 each semester for printing? (And \$15 in the summer!)

Don't need a print copy? The Libraries has high-speed scanners you can use for free!

Open Educational Resources (OERs)

OER textbooks are freely available materials created by professors and librarians.
