

UPPER-LEVEL ADMISSION

- All students enter the program as lower level (ARCL)
- Review occurs during March of Second Year:
 - 2.5 GPA
 - Complete Upper Level required courses
 - At least 54 hours complete in degree plan.


What your academic advisor


Scheduling Appointments: NAVIGATE

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



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
