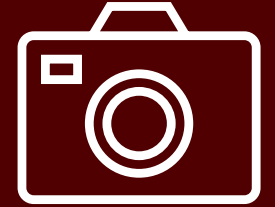


# UPPER-LEVEL ADMISSION

- All students enter the program as lower level (ARCL)
- Review occurs during March of Second Year:
  - 2.5 GPA

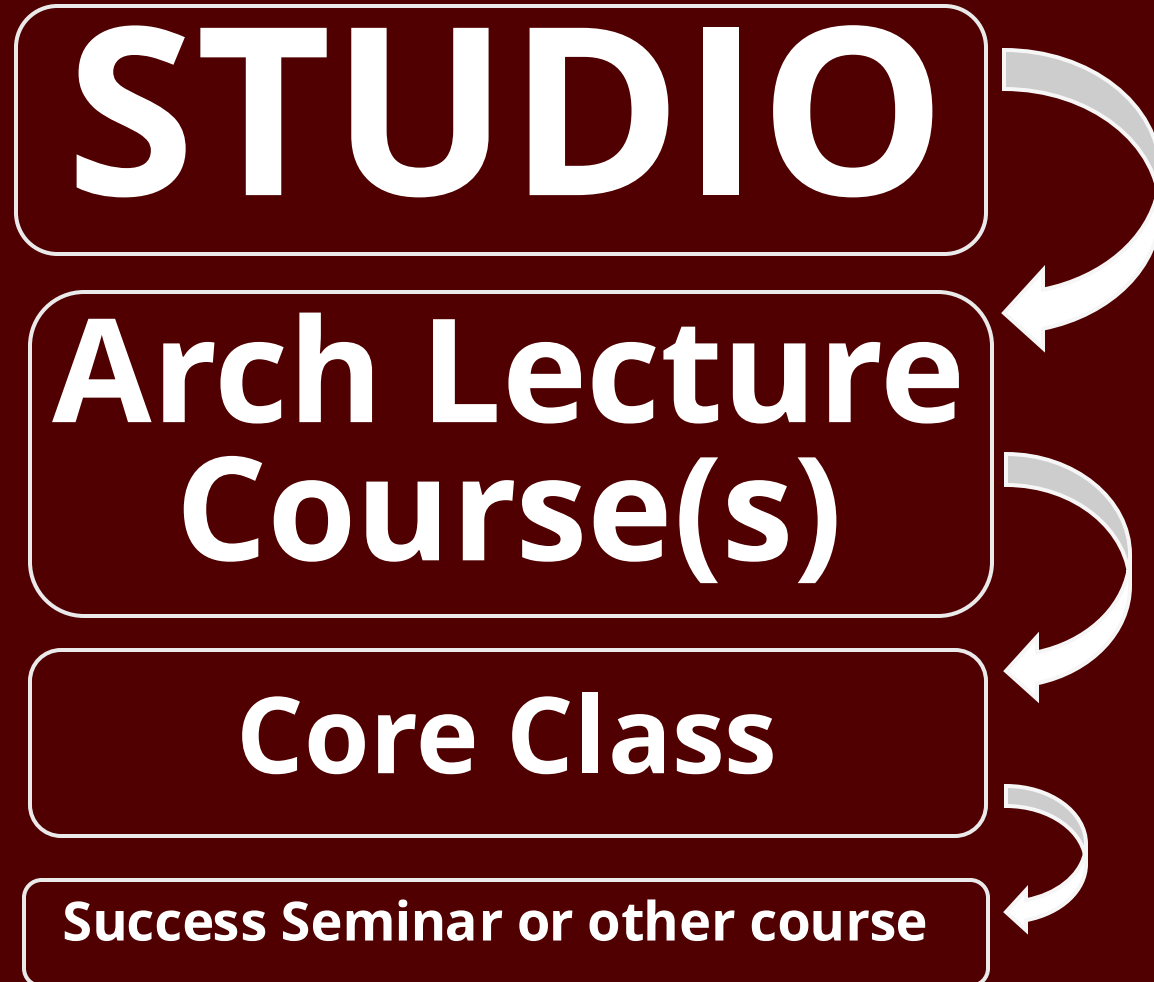
# Transfer Courses

- Research community college classes early. **Some courses have prerequisites and fill up quickly.**
- Admissions.tamu.edu ➡ Transfer ➡ Transfer Course Equivalency
- The student is responsible to researching and reviewing transfer course availability and requirements.
- Send official transcript to A&M Admissions, NOT US!

If you have not submitted final dual credit/transfer transcripts or AP Scores, make sure you do not sign up for classes you already have credit for. I can only account for classes currently in Howdy

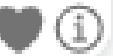



