



Tuition Freeze

As a result of actions taken by the Texas Legislature to address affordability in higher education, resident undergraduate tuition and fees will remain at the 2024-2025 rate for the 2025-2026 and 2026-2027 academic years



Tuition Rate Plan

Locked Rate

Option for Incoming Freshman or Transfer TX Residents

Locks in the amount of tuition and required fees at a per semester rate for 12 consecutive semesters

Calculated Locked Rate

Option for Incoming Transfer TX Resident

Locks in the amount of tuition and required fees that was in effect the first term of enrollment in college.

Variable Rate

All Non-TX Residents

Option for Incoming Freshman or Transfer TX Residents

Amount of tuition and can vary from year to year based on different economic factors.




Who Can Pay & When?


- **Student**
- **Authorized User (AU)**
 - ❖ Parent
 - ❖ Guardian
 - ❖ Spouse
 - ❖ Partner

A student can add as many AUs as they want.



Authorized Users (AU)

- View bills & remit payments to the student bill
- How do I become an AU?
 - Student sets up by entering the name and email address of the AU
 - Email sent to AU to complete account setup
- Authorized User (AU) access for bill payment is not the same as Parent/Guardian access to Howdy
- Any refund issued, will be issued to STUDENT, not AU



When Do I Pay?

Spring bills released as of January 5th

Payment in Full Due Date

- Due by 5pm, January 16th

Installment Plan Due Dates

- \$50 non-refundable service fee
- If enrolled, payment due by 5pm:
 - 1st payment January 16th
 - 2nd payment February 16th
 - 3rd payment March 16th
 - 4th payment April 16th

courses!**



Anticipated Aid & Financial Aid Disbursement

- What is Anticipated Aid?
 - Aid that is expected to be disbursed to the bill as a form of payment.
- What is disbursement?
 - Action of releasing the anticipated aid and applying it to the bill as a form of payment.
- Aid should be disbursed and apply to the bill as a form of payment within 1-2 business days.

Getting a Refund?

Refunds issued via direct deposit to STUDENT if a credit balance is on the account


Students MUST set up direct deposit by setting up their eRefunds

Excess financial aid

- **Title IV Refund** - federal financial aid in excess of required tuition and fees, housing and meals
 - You may receive a Title IV refund and still owe a balance.
 - Use the Title IV refund to make a payment.
- **Non-title IV Refund** - non-federal aid in excess of total balance due

Excess payments applied, registration changes (like dropping courses), or other reversal of charges

- Released after the add/drop registration period ends (5th class day)




Other Payments & Credits



Federal Direct Parent Plus Loan

- Federal loan parents may be eligible to apply for to help with educational expenses for their student.
- Parent PLUS Loans are applied to charges before other aid
- Refund will issue to the student UNLESS parent elects refund issued to self/parent when applying



Tuition Waivers & Exemptions

- Deadline to submit required documentation:
 - **12th class day** for the fall and spring
 - **4th class day** for summer
- Specialized Student Billing department handles applying exemptions and waiver payments to student account

Payments provided by third parties can include but not limited to:



Pre-Paid Tuition Plans

Texas Tuition Promise Fund

Must be authorized every semester on the TTPF website

Account Purchaser must authorize payment to an in-state Texas public college, university, or community college

To authorize TTPF to pay Texas A&M University for the semester, visit texastuitionpromisefund.com



Texas Guaranteed Tuition Plan

Must request to use TGTP in howdy.tamu.edu, instructions found at TGTP.tamu.edu

Plan will automatically apply to fall & spring; must request to use EACH summer

Pays for number of credit hours purchased in plan

Does not cover laboratory fees, course-specific fees, housing & food, books, sport passes

Private 529 College Savings Plans

Contact your plan administrator/financial institution to request withdrawal.

You can use tuition calculator to estimate tuition costs

Inquire if digital disbursement is available. Its quicker & you can often track the status of disbursement.

Mailed checks can take on avg, up to 2-3 weeks to be received and processed.

Payments not received by payment due date will require other payment arrangements to be made by due date.





Need More Time To Pay?

Need More Time to Pay?

Temporary funding in the event of an emergency or unexpected expenses:

Emergency Tuition & Fee Loan

- Pays required tuition and fees only
- Repayment up to 90 days
- A \$10 processing fee
- 5% simple interest

Short Term Loan

- Temporary funding that can be used for rent, books and other educational costs
- Repayment terms from 1 to 12 months
- A \$10 processing charge calculated on each loan's total amount
- 8%* simple interest per annum



** If the loan is not paid by the due date, additional late charges of 0.5% per month will accrue on the unpaid principal balance until paid in full.*

Optional Tuition Insurance




GradGuard Tuition Protection Plan
