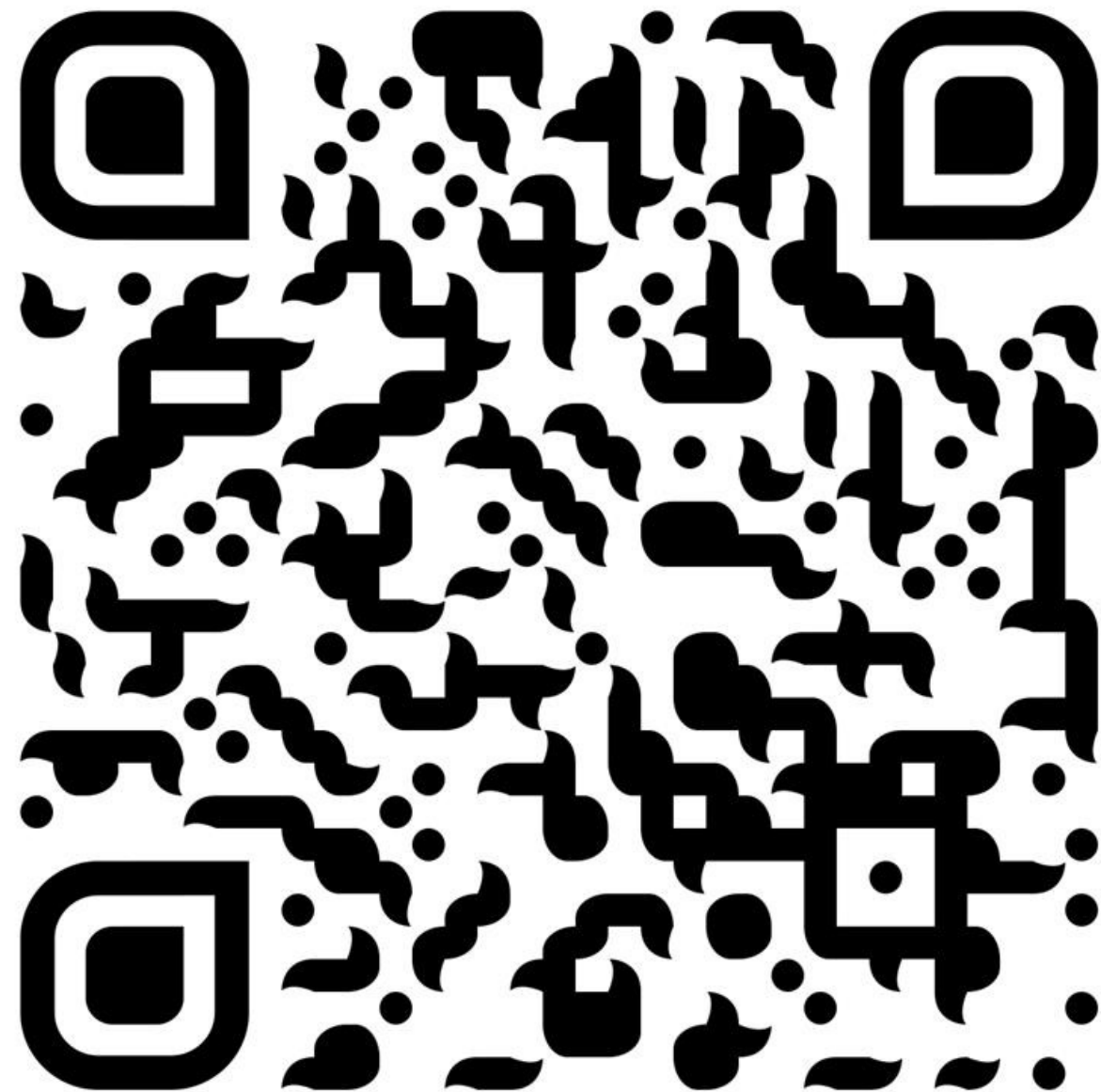

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA)

- You, the student, control your education records.
- Your rights:
 - See your records (with some exceptions)
 - Ask for corrections if something is wrong
 - You decide who sees your information
 - Report problems if rules are not followed
- Grades & Information:
 - Your information is only shared with your written consent or under FERPA rules.
 - Want family to see grades? Grant access in Howdy.

Common Violations

Some examples of academic misconduct at Texas A&M:

- Making up data or using AI without permission
- Giving false info or altering documents
- Using someone else's work without credit
- Helping others cheat or falsify work

AI & Aggie Honor Code

- Check each course syllabus for rules
- Use AI as a tool, not a shortcut
- Be transparent about using AI
- Always verify what AI tells you

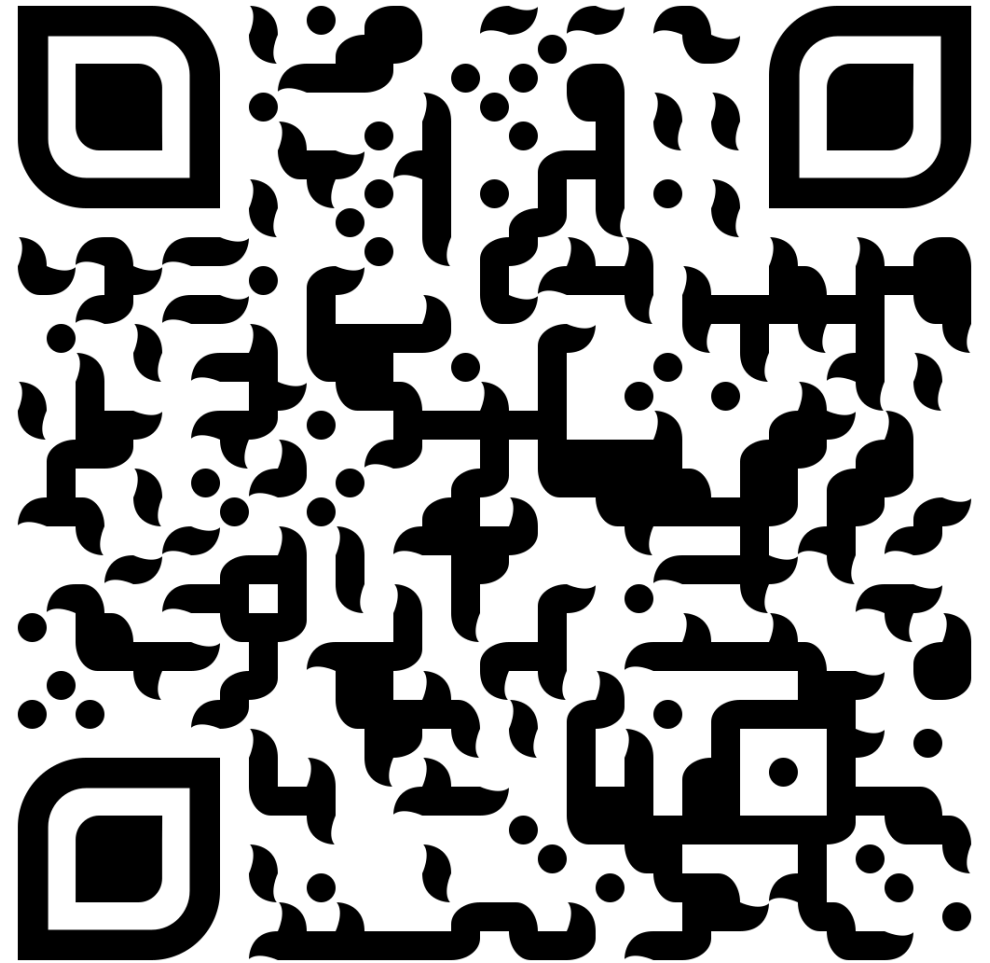

Appointment Policies

- **Schedule Appointments Online**

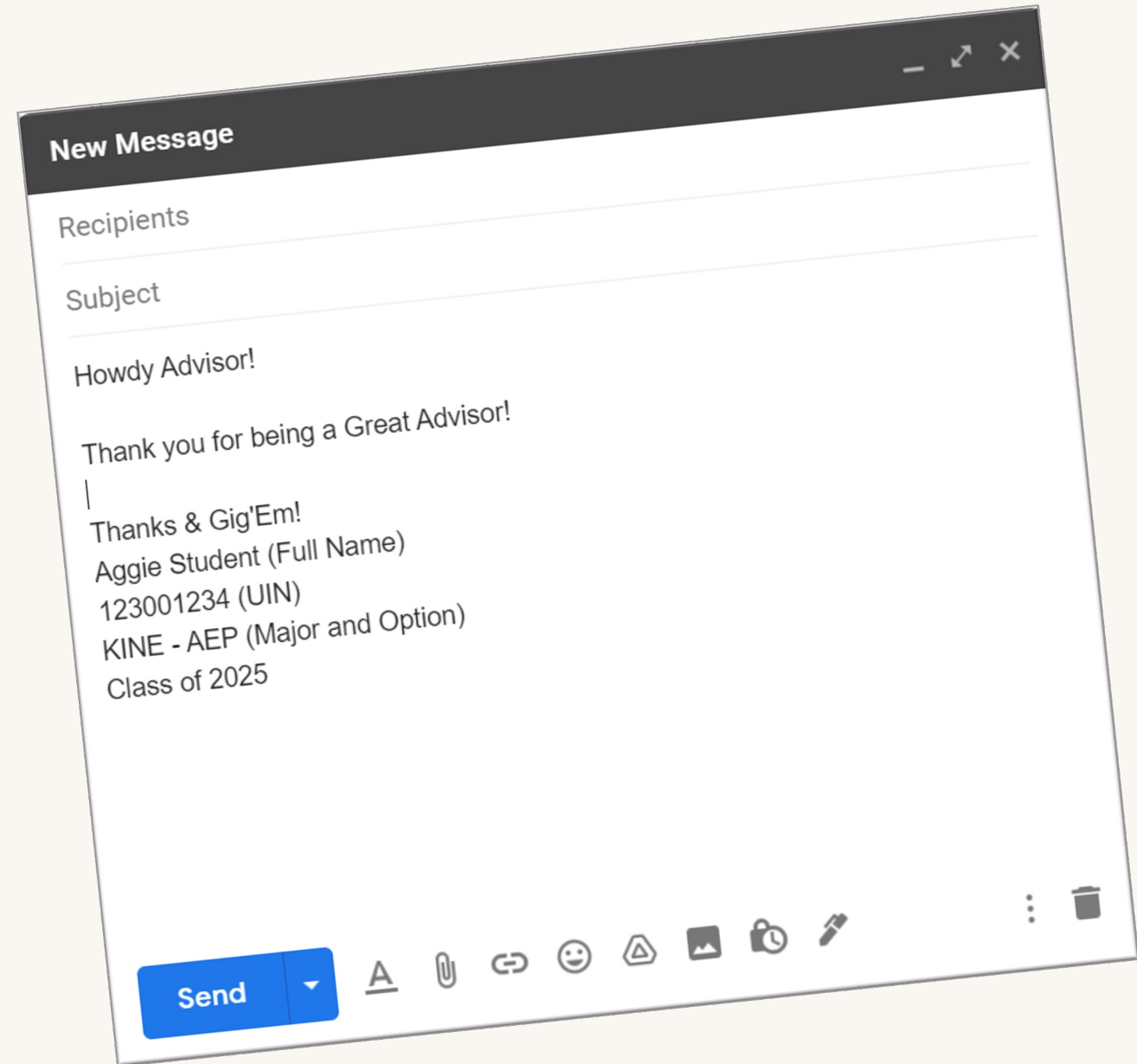
- Use NAVIGATE
 - *(Howdy>My Record>Schedule Advising Appointment)*
- Schedule up to 7 days ahead, at least 24 hours before
 - New appointment slots open Mon-Thur
- Can't make it? Cancel or reschedule
- Trouble scheduling? Call the office

- **Walk-in Advising Appointments**

- Friday mornings from 8:30 -11am

Official TAMU Email

- **Check daily!** (several times)
- **DO NOT** forward your A&M emails to your personal email address
- **Information to include in emails:**
 - Name
 - UIN
 - Major & Option (Example: *KINE-MTB*, *EDUC-PK6*, or *SPMT*)
- **Allow time for response**
 - Usually 24-48 hours
