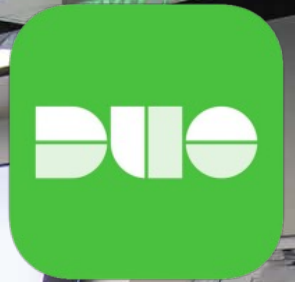
Make sure to select your Tuition Rate Code through the Howdy Portal.

DUO NetID Two-Factor AUTHENTICATION



Duo NetID Two-Factor Authentication adds a second layer of security to your NetID Account. Verifying your identity using a second factor (like your phone/other mobile device) prevents anyone but you from logging in, even if they know your password.

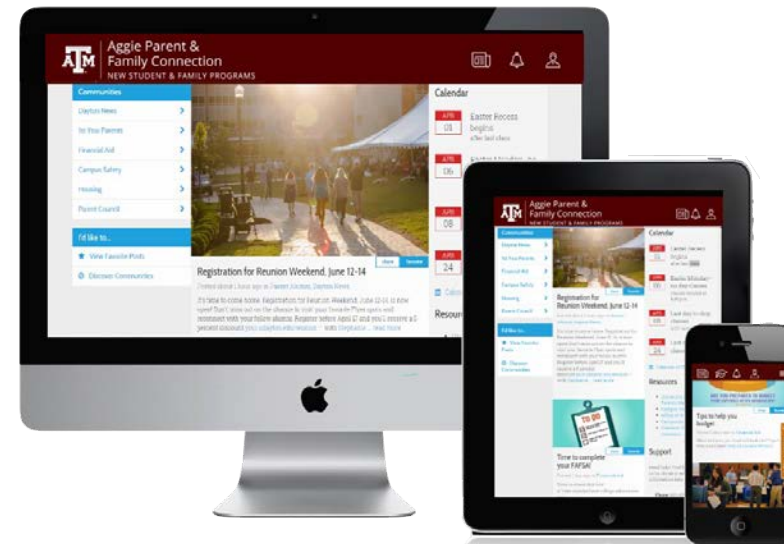

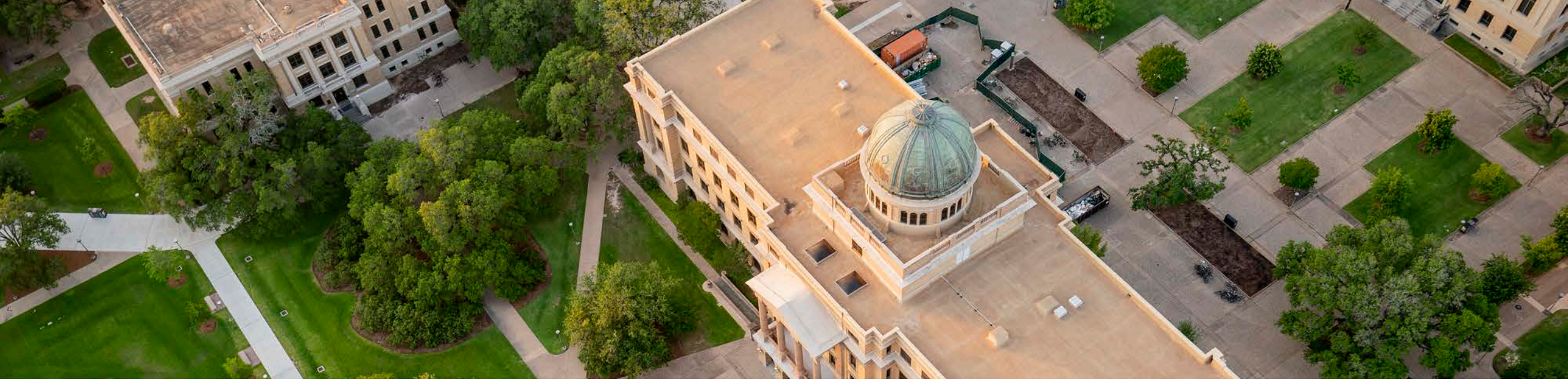
